Considering the extent to which we have freedom and responsibility to make choices in our lives.

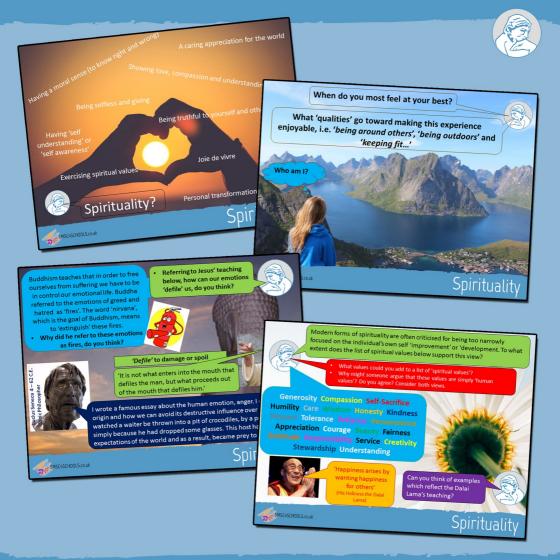
Encourage a positive self-image by reflecting, accepting and embracing our unique individuality.
